We hope members will get a group together, dress up in the traditional Derby Day Black/White, and join us for an afternoon of fun and fashion and a delicious afternoon tea.

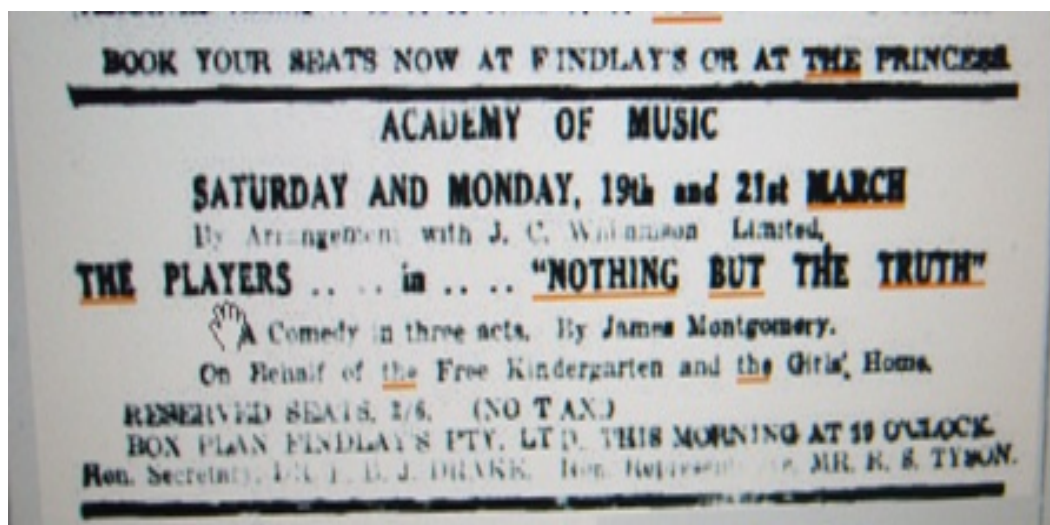
